

# Behaviour Consequence Flowchart

## Category 1

EXAMPLE:

Disruption, disengagement, refusal of instructions

Verbal Warning

Lose 10 minutes ride time

Lose 20 minutes ride time

Lose total ride time

Letter home

Meet with parent/guardian

Repeated Cat 1 cycle =  
Entry into Cat 2

## Category 2

EXAMPLE:

Escalation from C1, dangerous / unacceptable behaviour

Letter home

Meet with parent/guardian

Intervention strategy put in place

Fixed term exclusion

Alternative arrangement and support put in place

Outreach programme

Reintegration

Repeated Cat 2 cycle =  
Entry into Cat 3

## Category 3

EXAMPLE:

Being in an out-of-bounds area, Violence, aggression, drugs or alcohol, damage to property, theft, offensive or racially motivated materials, filming and posting on social media, extreme or persistent incidents of C2 behaviour.

Letter home

Meet with parent/guardian

Revised Intervention strategy put in place

Fixed term exclusion

Alternative arrangement and support put in place

Outreach programme

Reintegration

Learner pathway review

Permanent exclusion

This consequence flowchart is to be used as a guide. Persistent poor behaviour can be elevated in category at any time. The behaviours listed above are a guide and are not exhausted.

Parents/Guardians, referring agencies and other relevant stakeholders may be informed of behaviour consequence decisions at relevant meetings (PLP, etc...)
